

Did you know that you can redirect your tax dollars to a Catholic School of your choice?

The Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) is a tax credit that many individuals and businesses in Pennsylvania are eligible to receive. The program offers the donor a PA tax credit of 75% for a 1-year commitment and a 90% tax credit for a 2-year commitment. This donation can be designated to a Catholic School to help offset tuition for students who would otherwise not be able to attend a Catholic School.

INDIVIDUALS

Individuals with a tax liability can now join a Special Purpose Entity (SPE) like BLOCS or Foundation for Catholic Education to take full advantage of the PA EITC programs.

- Use the credit on personal PA taxes
- 90% tax credit for a 2-year commitment
- Designate to a Catholic school of your choice

BUSINESSES

PA businesses can contribute up to \$750,000 to the program. C-Corps, S-Corps, LLCs and Limited Partnerships are eligible to participate.

- Available to businesses in PA
- Receive a 75% credit for 1-year commitment or 90% credit for 2-years
- New businesses can apply by July 1st
- Designate to a Catholic school of your choice
